## RIDING ATTIRE

### HELMET

All students are required to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet. Girls should try the helmet on with their hair tucked up in it; since this is the way she will wear it when she rides (so send a rubber band to pull her hair back, large scrunch's are too big to be worn under the helmet).

### PANTS & BOOTS

Either riding breeches or jodhpurs are acceptable; both protect your child's legs. Traditionally, eleven (11) year old and under riders wear jodhpurs and gaiters (leather garters) with paddock boots (if your child is tall for their age then breeches and tall boots are best). Twelve (12) and over riders wear breeches with tall leather boots. Tennis shoes, cowboy boots and rubber riding boots are not suitable. There are many economically priced boots available to choose from. Call one of the tack shops listed below for your options.

### SHIRTS

T-shirts, polo shirts, and oxfords are all acceptable. Students will tuck their shirts in to ride, so avoid over-sized shirts.

## NON-RIDING ATTIRE

T-shirts, jeans, shorts, and tennis shoes are acceptable for non-riding activities. A hat or visor is also suggested. Shirts should cover up the belly button, and jeans should be the regular cut, not hip-huggers. We suggest you send a lightweight jacket or sweatshirt with your child as well as protection from sun and insects. Please note: your child will need to wear their boots whenever they work with their horses. Please put your child's name on any item/s sent with them.
