

ONE DAY HORSE SHOW INFORMATION

The show year is here once again. There are a few things that you need to have to make things run smoothly for you at the shows.

ASSOCIATIONS

Remember to join all associations and register all horses you ride even if it is just for one show. I have membership packets in the office if you need them.

Please photocopy all cards on one sheet of paper and on the top right hand corner include you name address and phone number and your SS# as well as your horses ID # and a copy of their cards as well.

Please remember to send in pre entries complete with ranch address as it takes extra time for me to fill it out on 10 entries when I get there. I suggest sending it in and verifying that there are enough people to go which allows you to save the late fees. All entries must be complete and copies of your membership cards to be processed, I can not pick up any numbers with out copies of your cards or horses registration number, so please leave me a copy as soon as you get them.

All one-day horses must have a separate set of wraps. Dark green under wraps and dark green stretch over wraps, these are kept separate from the training wraps so please label them with your name or your horse's name. You'll also need a dark green water bucket and a pair of bell boots. All supplies should be put under the tree by the tack room the day before the show.

Remember the difference between day care and grooming, Day care only includes lunging, loading and watching NO TACK UPS. Grooming includes everything. Both require tipping, a minimum of \$10.00 for day care and a minimum of \$20.00 for grooming, remember they start at 3am to get your horse to the show and prepared for you to ride.

Please remember when you sign up for the show, to completely fill out the sheet, I can not guess if you need hauling, grooming or a ride or not. It would be terrible to get to the show and not have a horse waiting for you. It takes a minimum of 5 to go to the show and a minimum of 7 to offer day care. If you cancel later than Wednesday pm before the show you are still responsible for hauling.

I have point record sheets in the office, as well as medal record sheets and specs. Please keep track as the associations frequently miss calculate, file a discrepancy report as soon as possible.
